Thank you so much for your interest in joining a Co-op! Co-ops are an integral part of our student ministry, and one of the most exciting ways for you to grow in your faith. Before filling out this application, we want to make sure that you know the vision for Co-ops and how they work. You will be asked to sign the application after completing it. With this signature you are not only stating that all of your information is correct, but you are also agreeing to follow our vision for co-ops. With that being said, here is the vision statement for co-ops:

- *That students would follow the example of Christ and experience spiritual transformation through community with a mentor and a few close companions seeking the same spiritual direction.*

Each Co-op will be completely different. The structure, meeting times, and discussion material will vary for each group, mainly depending on what the students are most interested in studying. However, each Co-op will be required to commit to three guidelines. First, you must meet once a week with only a few exceptions (vacation, holidays, etc.). Second, you will read through a book of the Bible or other previously approved book. Third, whatever is revealed about each person in the group is completely confidential. Co-ops will always be a safe place for you and others to share hurts, struggles, and questions.

Co-ops are one of the most effective ways for you to grow deeper in your faith, gain invaluable spiritual tools for dealing with growing up, and make lifelong friendships. You will be blessed immensely if you decide to join. While you fill out this application, please prayerfully consider if this is truly something that the Lord is leading you to join. Finally, know that this application is not a test in any way. It is merely a way for the student ministries staff to gain a greater knowledge of who you are and where you're at in life.
